If putting the address into google maps or similar mapping applications or websites then it will be listed as Broadstairs Chiropractic Clinic. As you look at the building, there is a drive to the right. Stephens close. Drive/walk up here and you will find Atlas place at the rear of the building. There are 2 car park places for you to use for the duration of your stay. Please do not park in front of the garages and do not move the bollards.

House keys:

You will find 1 gate key upon entry from the carpark and another to the right of the back door. Spare sets of house keys are provided for your convenience. All sets of keys comprise of the following; gate key, top lock key and dead lock key.

We will send you the codes on the morning of your arrival. We would suggest for ease that once you've opened the gate/door that you replace the key straight away) The main door to the house will lock behind you if you let it close so best to pop them back or put it on the latch whilst you empty the car

Please ensure that all keys are returned on check out, replacing a set of keys in the lock box and the solitary gate key in its outer box. Any lost keys will be charged at the cost.

Check In:

Check in time is 15:00 unless by prior arrangement.

Check Out:

Check out time is 10:00 unless by prior arrangement.

Your use of the facilities parking is limited to your stay with us, upon check out you will be expected to vacate the parking spaces. We ask that you do not touch the barriers.

To help our clean team we ask that you please strip the duvet covers, pillow cases and fitted sheets. These can just be left in the bedrooms and used towels placed in the bath please.

Wifi codes:

The wifi code will be available on arrival.

TV:

The TV in the lounge and master bedroom are both smart TV's and are internet enabled. Should you have your own TV streaming service such as Netflix then all you need to do is login. Each TV also has a connected Freeview box so all free to air satellite channels are available.

In the lounge TV unit, there is a selection of films for all ages.

The DVD player is also suitable for USB playback.

Heating:

The main bathroom has underfloor heating, we would ask that this is left unchanged.

Should you wish to put the heating on the thermostat on the main landing operates this. Simply press the dial and turn to the desired temperature. It's an old house but warms up quickly. We do not have the heating on a timer so it's free for you to alter for your comfort but we ask that you turn it off if you go out for the day.

The kitchen is equipped with a fire blanket, should you need more substantial fire fighting equipment then a CO2 fire extinguisher is located in the cupboard under the stairs. First aid kit on the extractor fan in the kitchen.

Clothes airers, ironing board, steam iron and hoover are all located in the cupboard under the stairs, please return them in the condition in which you found them.

Cleaning products are above the kitchen sink. Help yourself!

Parking:

There are two parking spaces for your use while you are at Atlas Place, these are clearly marked with private parking signs. Please only park here, the other areas at the rear of Atlas Place are in use or liable to be in use at all times.

Please note that when you check out at the end of your stay, we would be grateful if you would vacate the parking at the same time. If you have more than 2 cars then free on-street parking can be found on Pierremont avenue or King Edward. A 2 minute walk.

Buses & Trains:

The bus stop outside Atlas Place serves Broadstairs and the local towns of Ramsgate and Margate. 'The Loop' runs every 7 minutes with frequent stops all over Thanet.

There is also an open-top bus tour that runs during the summer season.

The train station to the surrounding towns is located at the top of the High Street and is on the South Eastern network arriving in London in just over an hour.

Bins & Recycling:

Bin day is a Thursday, so please ensure any rubbish or recycling you have is in the bins on Wednesday night, as they tend to come early, circa 6am. Bins are located in the alley at the side of the building.

Food waste goes out every week and should be placed in the brown caddy.

Paper and cardboard in the red bag/bin

Plastic, glass and cans/tins in the blue bin

All else, black bin.

Beaches:

The most local is Viking Bay. It's literally a 5min walk - if you turn left when you get to the front of the building and turn right down the hill, you will see the sea! There are a (long) set of steps at the prom, during the season (April to October) there is a lift (to the right of the steps) that takes you down to the beach.

Viking can be busy in the summer. If you want a slightly quieter beach then we suggest Stone bay - another 10 minute walk from Viking.

Being on the coast we are surrounded by beaches so you really can take your pick. Margate is a 5minute train ride away, huge beach with arcades and ice creams. Ramsgate has the only Royal Harbour in the country. Definitely worth a trip. You can walk to both of these along the beach but **please** check the tide times first. You can get caught out on the beach and when the tide is in you will get stuck so only go if it's safe. If not, you can walk along the road. Check out the Viking coastal trail.
